Netiquette (net + etiquette) is a code of conduct for virtual classrooms. Here is a quick list of do's and don'ts to make sure everyone has a safe online experience.

DO:

- Use academic language.
- Treat others the way you want to be treated.
- Check to see if a question has been asked before posting it again.
- Cite reliable sources.
- Proofread your posts.

DO NOT:

- Get off topic.
- Type in ALL CAPS. (It's considered yelling!)
- Post things you are not comfortable with everyone seeing, including your teachers and parents!
- Make sarcastic jokes. Tone is hard to read online.
- Mock or otherwise badmouth anyone.

If you wouldn't do it in person, don't do it online!
